Community Supported Agriculture & Grasshoppers

Community Supported Agriculture is the concept of people supporting a farm with a direct investment, and sharing in the return of the harvest. Their relationship with the farm, the fresh seasonal food that comes in the boxes every week, and sharing in the risks that make for a bountiful or poor harvest, all connect them to the place where they live. Meanwhile, the farm family has the resources it needs and a secure market throughout the year.

Grasshoppers has improvised on this model, to offer a multi-farm, all-natural and organically grown program that provides beef, chicken, pork, milk, cheese, and eggs as well as produce.

The Details

The season runs from May 18th through November 19th. Each share – whether it is from the produce, protein, or dairy category – is individually priced to allow you to design your very own basket. Any combination is possible, so long as your basket meets the \$300 minimum. Once a week or once every other week, depending on the shares you select, you will pick up your basket at one of our CSA sites throughout Louisville.

Our produce share is \$598 for 26 weeks, or \$23 a week. Each ¾ sized bushel box has between 6-8 seasonal items. Beginning this season we will also be offering the “Produce For Two!” Share for smaller households! A weekly newsletter tells you what items are in your basket, the farms they came from, and has recipes to help use the more adventurous items. We may substitute conventional items at times if needed to fill your box. These items will always be pointed out in the newsletter. Our farms raise their meat and dairy animals on pasture, without antibiotics, steroids or hormones. If for any reason you do not pick up your basket, we will see that it goes to food-insecure people here in Louisville.

Staples Share

Produce CSA

Ideal for households of one to two people (1/2 of the full share), each weekly delivery will contain 4-5 fresh and All-Natural or Organic produce items per week. \$438.

Milk Share

This non-homogenized milk comes in glass half-gallon jars from JD Country Milk, a family farm that is thinking outside the industrial milk box. One half gallon delivered every week. \$155. Includes \$52 refundable bottle deposit (\$2 per jar, refunded at the end of the season).

Pastured Eggs

_____ # of shares x \$135 = _____

These thick-yolked, vitamin rich eggs come from hens that spend their days being rotated in perennial pastures, under the sun. One dozen eggs each delivery. \$135.

Every Other Week Shares (13 deliveries) Keep in mind the delivery quantities for these shares will need to last you two weeks.

Mushrooms

_____ # of shares x \$125 = _____

Organic oyster mushrooms in a rainbow color mix, from Sheltopee Farm in Bath Co. A perfect complement to the produce share. A ¾ lb. bag with each delivery. \$125.

Have a Cow Cheese

_____ # of shares x \$145 = _____

Small dairies in KY are churning out batches of raw-milk aged artisan cheeses. Each delivery you receive two different 8 oz. cheeses. \$145.

Goat Cheese Gourmet

_____ # of shares x \$115 = _____

A selection of diverse surface-ripened, aged, and fresh cheeses from award-winning Capriole in Southern Indiana and Bluegrass Chevre in Fayette County, the first cheese maker in the Commonwealth to use 100% Kentucky Goat's Milk. One 4 or 8 oz. Goat Cheese delivered every other week. \$115.

Pastured Chicken

_____ # of shares x \$210 = _____

These chickens keep insect pests to a minimum with their pecking, and fields fertilized as the flock moves from one pasture to another. 1 frozen Whole Chicken in the 3-pound range each delivery. Using the whole chicken gets you the most value. \$210.

Pastured Beef

_____ # of shares x \$155 = _____

Raised in the pasture, this beef has higher levels of Vitamins A & E, and essential fatty acids. Over the course of thirteen deliveries, you will receive 14 lbs. of Ground Beef, 9 lbs. of Roast and 3 lbs. of Keabab Meat. \$155.

Breakfast Basket

_____ # of shares x \$210 = _____

These pigs have forests and pastures to roam, foraging on acorns and tubers in addition to their high quality grain ration. Deliveries will alternate between one lb. of Mild Sage Sausage with one lb. of Piggies (Sausage Links), and fresh bacon or sausage ropes with one lb. of Spicy Ground Sausage \$210.

Grass-Fed Lamb

_____ # of shares x \$260 = _____

From Garden of Eden Farm in Mt. Sterling. Eden Meyer raises her sheep on the grass for which Kentucky is famous. The limestone soils and abundant rain which nurture Kentucky's world famous thoroughbreds also produce world class grazing for our sheep. Over thirteen deliveries expect to get (approximations) 3 lbs Ground Lamb, 3 lbs Keabab Cubes, 2 (1 ½-2 lb) Boneless Shoulder Roasts, 2 (2 ½-3 lb) Boneless Leg Roasts, 4 pkgs Rack Chops, and 4 Shanks. \$260.

Mixed Meat

_____ # of shares x \$290 = _____

For the locavore who wants to try it all, here comes a diverse sampling from Kentuckiana's pastures and ponds. Weekly medleys will add up to these totals: Pork (3 lbs sage sausage and 6 lbs Italian rope sausage), Beef (6 lbs ground beef and 3 lbs hamburger patties), Chicken (3 whole at app. 3 lbs each), Lamb (3 lbs ground lamb), Catfish (8 fillets), and Kentucky striped bass (4 filets).
